

## Hurstpierpoint Gymnastics Club

is open to children from the age of three to sixteen and from any school. The Club has qualified coaches and is registered with the British Gymnastics Association - supporting its award scheme. It meets in Hurstpierpoint Village Centre. All classes operate term-times excepting December & July.

**Pre-School Groups** meet on Friday afternoons,  
**Boys** at 1pm & 1.30pm,  
**Girls** at 2pm & 2.30pm.

**Boys** of school age 4 to 7 meet on Tuesdays at 4.30pm,  
**Boys** age 7 and above on Tuesdays at 5.30pm.

**Girls** of school age 4 to 7 meet Wednesdays or Thursdays, 4pm

**Girls** aged 7 to 10 meet Wednesdays 5pm or Thursdays 6pm

**Girls** aged 10 to 16 meet Wednesdays 6pm or Thursdays 7pm

We have waiting lists for most groups and for those coming to pre-school age. Please contact us for the up-to date position.

**Fees** The club has to pay its way and fees are charged each term or remaining part of in advance. All awards are presented free.

Children should arrive ready changed as the club is unable to provide changing facilities.  
Warm clothing required to wear afterwards.

**Spectating** is discouraged in all groups as this tends to inhibit the children - though if your child has difficulties settling in or if you wish to observe a session, please ask.

**Safety** :- No jewellery should be worn and long hair should always be tied back. All work is done barefoot.

We operate a `one club` rule; apart from school clubs we will not accept or keep children who also attend other gym clubs or classes. Children may transfer to us or from us as they wish.

At the end of the Spring Term the Arts Festival Competition is open to all girls in Year 3 and above. There are sections for group sports acrobatics, beam pairs and rhythmic pair & solo competitions, using different equipment each year.

On the first Saturday of July, the Club holds its Annual Championships when both the girls and boys have floor solo and vault competitions, the girls also compete at pairs.

**Club leotards** are available for purchase from the club, but they are not essential. Any coloured leotard will suffice or even tee-shirt and shorts.

**Club tee-shirts** are also available from the club, subsidised to just £2 each, subsidised by our grants.
